BOARDING POLICY
<p>Boarding is different from hospitalization in that it is provided for healthy animals not needing intensive care or treatment. Of course, should your pet require any medical or preventative treatment while boarding, you can rest assured that he/she will receive it.</p> <p>If a medical condition develops with your pet, every attempt will be made to contact you or the designated emergency contact. IF WE CANNOT REACH YOU, how would you like us to proceed?</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> I hereby authorize RRAH to do whatever diagnostic tests, treatment, and/or surgeries that are necessary should an emergency situation arise. I understand that if I or my emergency contact may not be reached, my pet will not receive further medical treatment EVEN IF IT IS LIFE THREATENING.</p> <p>All pets entering River Road Animal Hospital must have a physical exam within one year, current on all required vaccines at least two weeks prior to boarding, and be free of internal and external parasites. If these conditions are not met, the appropriate services will be provided and charged accordingly.
